I would like to start this month's article by introducing our new Assistant Golf Course Superintendent, Adam Lott, who comes to our club from McCall, Idaho. He has a turf certificate from the Mundus Institute of Golf Course Management located in Mesa, Arizona and has spent the last 6 years as Assistant Golf Course Superintendent at Jug Mountain Golf Course in McCall. Please help me in welcoming Adam when you cross paths.

March brought abundant rainfall, 5.5 in. to be exact. This kept the carts on the cart paths, but our irrigation ponds benefited by being filled to capacity. Making a cart path decision is one of the hardest decisions to make. We travel the fairways each day after a rain event to see if they are suitable for cart traffic. If there is the potential to injure the turf, then we put the "Carts on Paths" signs up at the first and tenth tees. Please pay close attention to these postings, as we try to help protect our club's number one asset, the golf course.

Your staff has been very busy this spring despite the rainfall. We are currently working to get the perennial flowerbeds cleaned and mulched for the season, making critical pre-emerge applications for crabgrass and goose grass control and finishing up the quick coupler insertion project. A load of soil is now on site and we will be finished filling in the old hose vaults by the time you read this article.

The practice tee will have a new look this season. Your golf course management staff has made tee markers for the top of the tee which will replace the square of rope that used to be there. I ask that when the tee markers are placed out on the tee that you try and stay between the markers when practicing. The markers will be moved on a daily bases, to allow for more time on the grass portion of the tee. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.

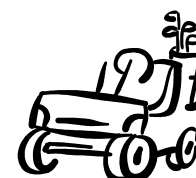

Servicing and maintaining the member owned golf cars will be of high importance to my golf staff. With that said I would like to offer a brief description of services that will be available through the golf shop.

- *Battery cable replacement \$10 ea.
- *Topping off water levels in batteries with distilled water \$8
- *Cart Cleaning \$10
- *After market additions such as sand bottle holders, club cleaners, covers, etc.



We also have a mechanic on site to handle larger problems or services with electric and gasoline carts. He will be available after 3pm on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. His cost will be \$40/hr. plus cost of parts needed to fix your cart. The repair on your cart will be done in a timely manner. Please schedule all repair or maintenance requests through the golf shop.
