As I write this article, the forecasted high is 99 degrees and humid. This was the norm for the month of July and the bentgrass on our greens is letting us know that they are ready for a cool down. The month of August is what I consider late summer when the bentgrass is at its weakest point. The roots are short and the density of the turf is less than perfect. All of which are normal. However, the longer nights of August are good for the greens in that the amount of direct sunlight beating down on them is reduced. This gives the grass plants longer to recover before the next hot day begins.

The green committee is trying something new with the placement of the bunker rakes in the bunkers. My staff has been asked to place the rakes in the middle of the bunkers after they rake them. The committee is asking for your help as golf playing members to try and return them to the centers after you use them. This will help reduce labor costs associated with moving the rakes before mowing and it will help prevent problem lies caused by rake interference while playing the game. Thank for you cooperation.

I write this article as I finish my first full year as your Golf Course Superintendent. It has been very enjoyable and I look forward to many more. Just a reminder that greens aerification is scheduled for Tuesday, September 6th. Play well and enjoy the course.

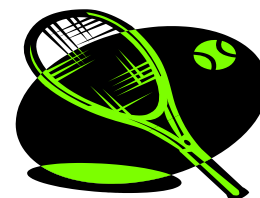
