September begins the fall season in which the cool season grasses begin to thrive once again and the warm season grasses begin to prepare themselves for dormancy. This month we will be aerifying our putting surfaces. I get asked the question, "Jeff, why do we have to punch holes in a green that is already perfect?" Please allow me to explain. Aerification serves 4 purposes. First, it allows for the carbon dioxide that has built up in the soil to release into the atmosphere and be replaced with beneficial oxygen. Second, it allows water to enter the soil more easily. Third, it allows a channel for nutrients to enter the soil for plant uptake. Last but not least, it reduces soil compaction to promote root growth. Longer roots is our ultimate goal for next summer survival. The aerification process disrupts ball roll for a couple of weeks, but the process allows me to grow healthy turf all year long.

This month we begin to change the way we mow the golf course to help prepare the Bermuda for winter dormancy. This is key to good green-up next season by assisting the turf to store carbohydrates in its root system. We do this by raising the height of the turf in our fairways to 1 inch. We also make a late season fertilizer application.

Starting October 1st, we are going to be removing the cart traffic from #3 fairway. This fairway was our thinnest one this spring and most of that was related to cart traffic last fall/winter. We will be doing this to see if conditions will improve for next year. A rope will be put up the whole length of the hole, so please keep your carts on the path for this hole only.

September is the month for us golf course workers to begin spending more afternoons at home with family and less time watering our greens. We as a staff would like to thank you as members for being patient while we hand watered greens this summer. We have had a great summer and I look forward to a nice fall. Hope to see you soon!
